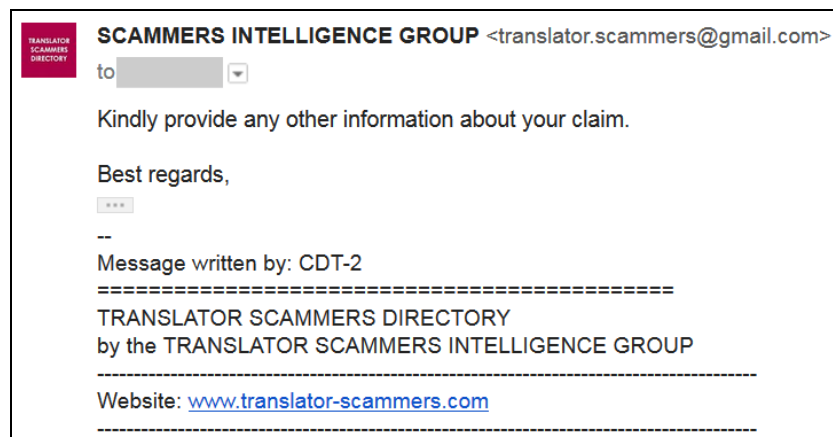
NAMING AND SHAMING? NO, THANK YOU.
